The Series helps people learn how to speak up for themselves and make a difference.



Each class is interactive and fun! That means that everyone who joins us will be involved in exercises, role-plays and other activities that will help you learn about:

**Being a Leader**  
**Public Speaking**  
**Voting, Testimony and Government**  
**Rights and Responsibilities**  
**Participating in Meetings**  
**Decision-Making and Planning for Your Future**  
**Self-Advocacy *and more!***

It's ok if you don't read or write. We use pictures, video and audio tapes, games and other interesting materials. Everyone has a way to understand what's going on!

The Series begins with an overnight retreat on **Wednesday September 17th - Thursday, September 18th, 2008 at Alton Jones campus in West Greenwich, RI.** Everyone in the class must attend the retreat.

After our retreat, the Leadership Series meets approximately twice a month from October thru May. Classes are usually on a Friday afternoon in Cranston (on the public bus route). There are also homework assignments and extra events to attend between classes. Everyone who completes the Series will graduate at a formal ceremony in June, 2009.
